#### GENERAL INFORMATION

The following age divisions will apply to both men and women for all individual, doubles competitions: 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90-94; 95-99; and 100+. Age divisions for competition will be determined by the age of the athlete as of December 31, 2024. For all doubles competitions and team sport competitions, the age division will be determined by the age of the youngest participant in the pair or group as of December 31, 2024. No onsite registration is allowed. Cannot guarantee partner if requested.

The top four finishers in age, gender, and division will advance to the National Senior Games to be held July 24 – Aug 3, 2025 in Des Moines, Iowa.

## MEDALS

Medals are given to 1<sup>st</sup> (Gold), 2<sup>nd</sup> (Silver), 3<sup>rd</sup> (Bronze) in each age group. The Indiana State Games allows and encourages athletes from out of state to participate. The definition of an athlete's state of residence is that state in which the person resides for at least six months out of the year.

## EQUIPMENT

**Site Fee: \$9.00 per session Payable to River City Recreation at time of bowling event (covers lane fee).** Bowling shoes and balls are available to rent on site. Participants can use own ball and shoes. Bowling center staff will take care of lane assignments and manage the bowling center.
