- This tournament will be by age and skill level. Four Skill Level Divisions: 3.0 and under, 3.5, 4.0, and 4.5/5.0

CLOTHING

The Indiana State Games does not allow players to where a shirt color that is like the ball used in the tournament. **Ball is neon, athletes will not be able to wear like color.**

<u>Players MUST wear court shoes. You may be asked to change shoes. Court surface is</u> hardcourt tennis courts. No crocs, sandals, etc. are allowed during play.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The following age divisions will apply to both men and women for all individual, doubles and relay competitions: 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75-79; 80-84; 85-89; 90-94; 95-99; and 100+. Age divisions for competition will be determined by the age of the athlete as of December 31, 2024. For all doubles competitions, the age division will be determined by the age of the youngest participant in the pair or group as of December 31, 2024. No onsite registration is allowed. The top four finishers in age, gender, and division will advance to the National Senior Games to be held July 24 – Aug 3, 2025 in Des Moines, lowa.

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

We have had players check court times incorrectly and leave the venue. This is a notice to alert players that when you are called to court and are not onsite, you may be DQ from that event.

ENTRY REGULATIONS

- 1. Athletes may compete with only one partner per event. Under NSGA rules, doubles and mixed doubles are classified as events. Therefore, athletes may not compete in more than one age division for doubles or mixed doubles.
- 2. Age/Skill doubles and mixed doubles will be determined by the higher skill player and the lower aged player as of 12/31/2024.
- 3. Athletes must supply current USAPA rating. If an athlete does not have a skill rating, they will need to refer to the document posted on NSGA.com under the Pickleball sports page in order to determine their skill rating.
- 4. Competitors must provide their own paddles. Balls will be provided

MEDALS

Medals are given to 1st (Gold), 2nd (Silver), 3rd (Bronze) in each age group. The Indiana State Games allows and encourages athletes from out of state to participate. The definition of an athlete's state of residence is that state in which the person resides for at least six months out of the year.

EQUIPMENT

Participants will use their own approved paddles, but balls will be provided. Courts will be set up by coordinator and staff at Evansville Tennis Center.

COORDINATOR

Deli Stinnett will be running this event. Coordinator will be responsible for all event issues that arise. Coordinator will record scores on result sheets and award medals.
